Clean-up of Vomiting and Diarrheal Events. 1. Close or block off the affected area using signage or a safety cone. Using a commercial biohazard kit, put on disposable plastic apron, face mask, shoe covers, then put on disposable gloves. 2. Sprinkle absorbent material onto the spill and allow it to stand for the time specified by the product label or until the fluid is fully absorbed and jelled.

Clothing and linens Remove visible vomit and/or stool from clothing/linen before washing. Separate contaminated items from regular laundry. Use detergent and a 1/2 cup of bleach to wash clothing and linens according to label directions. If bleach cannot be used, use an oxygenated detergent according ...

Norovirus: step-by-step clean up of vomit and diarrhea ...

- Use soapy water to wash surfaces that contacted the vomit or diarrhea and all nearby surfaces, such as door knobs and toilet handles.
- Rinse thoroughly with plain water and wipe dry with paper towels.
- Clean and disinfect any non-disposable tools (mop heads) used.

SAMPLE Procedure for the Clean-up of Vomit/Fecal Events

Persons cleaning vomit or faeces should wear gloves, apron and a mask. Paper towels should be used to soak up excess vomit and faeces and disposed of in a leak

Vomiting and diarrheal accidents should be cleaned up using the following recommended steps: Segregate the area of no less than 25 feet in radius in the likelihood of aerosolization of virus particles. Wear disposable gloves during cleaning.

Clean-up Procedures for Vomit & Diarrheal Accidents
The FDA addressed this issue directly by including guidance for the proper response to vomit and diarrheal events in the 2009 and 2013 versions of the US Food Code. Food Establishments are required to have procedures for employees to follow when responding to events that involve the discharge of vomit and diarrhea onto surfaces in the Food Establishment.

After either vomit or diarrhea incidence immediately clean and disinfect contaminated surfaces. Use a chlorine bleach solution with a concentration of 1000-5000 ppm (5-25 tablespoons of household bleach [5.25%] per gallon of water) or other disinfectant registered as effective against Norovirus by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
